### **Acts 1-5: The Early Church and the Holy Spirit**

**1. Acts 1:8 - Jesus promises the Holy Spirit and outlines the mission for His followers. What does being a witness for Christ mean in your life today?**

**2. Acts 2:1-13 - How does the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost demonstrate God's power and plan for the church?**

**3. Acts 4:19-20 - Peter and John boldly declare their loyalty to God over human authority. How can we apply this boldness in facing opposition to our faith?**

### **Acts 6-9: The Growth and Persecution of the Church**

**4. Acts 6:1-7 - What does the apostles' decision to appoint deacons teach us about prioritizing ministry roles and meeting the church's needs?**

**5. Acts 7:54-60 - Stephen forgave his persecutors as they stoned him. How does his example of forgiveness challenge you in your relationships?**

**6. Acts 9:1-19 - Saul's conversion on the road to Damascus is a pivotal moment. How does his transformation encourage us to believe in God's power to change hearts?**

### **Acts 10-15: The Gospel Expands to the Gentiles**

**7. Acts 10:9-16 - Peter's vision about clean and unclean animals leads to including Gentiles in the church. How does this challenge prejudices or barriers in spreading the Gospel today?**

**8. Acts 13:46-49 - Paul and Barnabas focus on preaching to the Gentiles after being rejected by the Jews. What does this teach us about handling rejection in ministry?**

### **Acts 16-19: Missionary Journeys and Challenges**

**9. Acts 16:25-34 - Paul and Silas sing hymns in prison, leading the jailer to salvation. How does their response to suffering inspire us to witness difficult circumstances?**

**10. Acts 19:11-20 - How did Paul's ministry in Ephesus demonstrate the power of the Gospel over spiritual darkness?**
