

1. When and where were you baptized?

2. How did Priscilla, Aquila, and Apollos show their fellowship/partnership with Paul in Acts 18:18-28? List all the ways you see (note 1 Corinthians 3:5-9)

3. How do Priscilla and Aquila's actions in instructing Apollos exemplify the importance of discipleship and mentorship in the early church?

4. Both Apollos and the disciples Paul met had a similar gap in their information about the Gospel. What did they know? Acts 18:25, 19:3-7

5. Apollos was from Egypt V24; these disciples were 800 miles from Jerusalem. What does the fact that they were both followers of John the Baptist tell us about the extent of his influence? How would their awareness of John be good preparation for them to hear the Gospel? (Note John 1:19-34)

6. When the faith spreads quickly, it is common for some “disciples” to understand the Gospel in a distorted way or partially. What steps can we take to ensure that new believers understand clearly, and what can we do when we find people confused? (Note Acts 8:14, 11:22, 14:21-23)

7. Why was it essential to be baptized in the name of Jesus, not just for repentance as John had done? (Note Romans 6:3-11)

8. What did the laying on of hands signify in Acts 19:6? Why did these disciples need evidence of the Spirit's presence?

9. Why are baptism into Jesus and the indwelling of the Holy Spirit important in your life? How do your attitudes and actions reflect these events?
