**Verses 7-12: Eutychus Raised to Life**

**3. Why do you think Luke included the story of Eutychus in this passage?**

**4. Paul speaks "on and on" into the night, leading to Eutychus falling asleep and out of the window. What does this show us about the importance of balancing our spiritual passion with practical needs?**

**5. How does the miracle of Eutychus being raised to life illustrate God's power and the importance of community worship?**

**Verses 13-16: Paul's Dedication to His Mission**

**6. Paul bypasses Ephesus to save time so he can reach Jerusalem for Pentecost. What does this reveal about his sense of mission and priorities?**

**7. How can we, like Paul, discern when to stop and invest deeply in people and when to move forward for the sake of a broader mission?**

**8. In what ways can you prioritize encouraging others in your community this week?**
