**5. Read Acts 27:30-32. What does Paul's interaction with the soldiers and sailors reveal about trust and obedience?**

**6. How do you typically respond when life takes an unexpected, difficult turn?**

**7. What lessons can we learn from Paul's faith and leadership in crisis?**

**8. How can we encourage others to trust God's faithfulness when they are struggling?**
