6. What kind of Savior do people want today? 2 Timothy 4:3

7. How is that different from the Savior we actually need? Ezekiel 36:26;
Luke 9:23

8. What does it look like to follow Jesus when His kingdom looks like a cross instead of a crown? Philippians 2:5–7; Proverbs 3:5–6

9. Where in your life is Jesus calling you to trust Him—even when it doesn't meet your expectations? Isaiah 55:8–9; Romans 8:28
