6. Why did he count it all as loss?

7. What does “the surpassing worth of knowing Christ” mean to you personally?

8. Write down three things competing with Jesus for your heart’s affection. How might you begin surrendering them to Him?

The Call to Treasure Jesus Daily Read: Luke 9:23–25

9. What does “deny yourself” and “take up your cross” mean?

10. How does this relate to treasuring Jesus above all?

11. How can we practically treasure Jesus daily above comfort, success, relationships, or recognition?
